Transportation

Department of Motor Vehicles

- 60 days to renew license if expires this month
- 60 days to renew vehicle registration if due this month. You may choose to take no action during the waiver period. If you take no action, when the state of emergency has passed you will have 60 days to have your vehicle inspected and complete the registration process. If you have already obtained a passing vehicle inspection, you may renew your registration online at <https://renew.txdmv.gov/>.
